POLICY:

Only motions and Board directions reached by the Board, acting as a whole and recorded in the Board minutes, are binding on the Chief Executive Officer (CEO).

Accordingly:

- 1. Instructions of individual Board members, officers, or committees are not binding on the CEO except in rare instances when the Board has specifically authorized such exercise of authority.
- 2. In the case of Board members or committees requesting information or assistance without Board authorization, the CEO can refuse such requests that require, in the CEO's opinion, a material amount of staff time or funds or is disruptive, or the request conflicts with legislation
