




# Population Statistics 2023



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
## About This Report


# Zone Descriptions

4. Zone 4 – East Area









# 10-Year Population Growth: 2013-2023


Between 2013 and 2023, Southern Health-Santé Sud experienced a 10-year growth rate of 20.7%, adding 38,729 more residents to the current total population of 226,113. From 2022 to 2023, Southern Health-Santé Sud saw a 1.7% growth increase with the addition of 3,744 more residents.

## Manitoba RHA Comparisons


Southern Health-Santé Sud, with a 20.7% increase over the past decade, is Manitoba's fastest-growing RHA against a provincial growth of 12.5%. Winnipeg also grew by 13.5%, outpacing Northern at 3.3%, Prairie Mountain at 5.7%, and Interlake-Eastern at 9.2% among other rural RHAs.



Manitoba has grown over by 161,210 residents over the past decade. While Winnipeg continues to be the primary driver of Manitoba's population increase, contributing 61.4% with 98,928 new residents, Population Statistics 2023: Southern Health-Santé Sud

Southern Health-Santé Sud also plays a significant role, adding 38,729 new residents and accounting for 24% of growth.

At nearly a quarter of total population growth, Southern Health-Santé Sud has seen the largest increase among rural RHAs. This population growth pattern for regions across Manitoba has been fairly consistent over the years.



## Age Group Comparisons

Southern Health-Santé Sud's population continues to grow across almost all age groups. Southern Health-Santé Sud sees a significantly higher increase in population than Manitoba within the 0-14 and 55-64 age groups, with a notable difference of 10% or above in both cohorts.

Both Manitoba and Southern Health-Santé Sud are experiencing a large aging population, with the fastest growing cohort being those aged 65-74 years, increasing by 43% in Manitoba and 50% in Southern Health-Santé Sud, respectively. On the contrary, the age range of 45-54 years has either decreased by -6% in Manitoba or remained stagnant at 0% change in Southern Health-Santé Sud.



# District and Municipal Population Change

## Population Growth by Districts


The figure below shows the population growth within the region by districts. The districts of Cartier-SFX and Stanley experienced the highest rates of growth at 54%, and 53% respectfully.

The districts which experienced a high population change of 25% or more are:

*Cartier-SFX, Macdonald, Morden city, Stanley, Ste Anne – La Broquerie, Hanover, and Niverville-Richot.*

In contrast, the districts which experienced the least population change of 5% or less are:

*Seven Regions, Red River South, and Grey.*
