

Population Statistics 2024: Southern Health-Santé Sud

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## **About This Report**

This report provides an analysis of the 2024 population statistics for Southern Health-Santé Sud (SH-SS) based on records of residents actively registered with Manitoba Health, Seniors, and Long-Term Care as of June 1, 2024. This population database is considered a reliable and accurate estimate of population sizes, and is helpful for understanding trends, and for health planning purposes.

Southern Health-Santé Sud acknowledges that the land on which it gathers is Treaty 1 and Treaty 3 territory, and the homeland of the Métis Nation. We respect the treaties that were made on these territories and acknowledge the harms and mistakes; and we dedicate ourselves to move forward collaboratively in the partnership with First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples in the spirit of reconciliation.

### Population Overview (2024)


Southern Health-Santé Sud (SH-SS) consists of **4 zones and 23 districts**, including **4 cities**, **5 towns**, **1 village**, **7 First Nations communities**, and **28 municipalities**. It remains the fastest-growing regional health authority in Manitoba. Over the past decade (2014–2024), SH-SS grew by **21.7%**, adding **41,462 residents**—significantly outpacing the provincial average of **13.8%**. In the past year alone (2023–2024), SH-SS saw a **2.74%** increase, adding **6,190 new residents**. The total population of SH-SS for 2024 as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 is **232**, **303**.

Key insights:

- Strongest Growth Areas: Population growth is concentrated in urban centres and nearby communities:
  - Winnipeg (Niverville Town, Ritchot RM, Headingly RM, Macdonald RM)
  - Portage la Prairie City (**Portage RM**)
  - Morden/Winkler Cities (Stanley RM)
  - o Steinbach City (Ste. Anne Town, Hanover RM)
- Aging Population: In SH-SS, the 65–74 age group grew by 49% over the past decade, which may indicate an increased need for senior healthcare services.
- **Regional vs. Provincial Trends:** SH-SS outpaced Manitoba's growth in younger age groups **(0–24)** and seniors **(65–74)**, while Manitoba sees a slight decline in working-age populations **(45–54)**.
- **Population Growth in Zones 3 and 4:** These areas saw the highest growth, which may have implications for future planning.
- **Projections:** The population of SH-SS is projected to reach almost **260,000** by the year **2030**, based on current growth trends.




# **Provincial & Regional Population Trends**


**Over the past decade**, **Manitoba's** population grew by 179,680 residents (+13.8%), reaching 1,485,989. Most of this growth was concentrated in Winnipeg and SH-SS, which together accounted for 86% of the total increase.

**Southern Health-Santé Sud** was the fastest-growing Regional Health Authority (+21.7%) in Manitoba, adding 41,462 residents. This was a higher growth rate than both Winnipeg (+15.2%) and the provincial average (+13.8%).

In the last year, SH-SS grew by 6,190 new residents (+2.74%). Winnipeg and SH-SS saw the most growth, while Northern region saw a slight decline.




## Population Growth in Southern Health-Santé Sud

### Zones

From 2023 to 2024:

- **Zone 4** (East) saw the highest growth (+3.8%, +3,381 residents)
- Zone 3 (West) followed (+2.8%, + 1,621 residents)
- Zone 1 (North) and Zone 2 (Mid) had smaller increases of +1.7% and +1.2% respectively



From 2014 to 2024:

- Zone 4 continued to lead In growth (+30.2%, +22,097)
- Zone 3 followed (+19.1%, +9,646,)
- Zone 1 and Zone 2 had steady increases (+16.1% and +13.9%)


### Districts


Over the last decade, districts with high growth of over 25% are:

- Stanley (+58.2%)
- Cartier-SFX (+54.7%)
- Niverville Ritchot (+44.9%)
- Ste Anne La Broquerie (+44.2%)
- Hanover (+40.9%)
- Macdonald (+30.8%)
- Taché (+27.1%) and
- Morden City (+26.6%).

In contrast, the districts which experienced the least population change of 5% or less are:

- Red River South (-0.2%) and
- Grey (Notre Dame-St. Claude) (4.8%)

### Population Growth by Age Group


#### From 2014-2024

#### **Older Ages**

- Southern-Health Santé Sud is experiencing a rapid aging population, particularly in the 65-74 age group which grew 49% in the past decade outpacing Manitoba's 40% growth in the same group.
- Although the **75+** age group remains the smallest, it recorded **significant growth** rates in both SH-SS and Manitoba.

#### Young and Middle Ages


- At the same time the **0-14 and 15-24** age groups **grew faster than Manitoba's** average, showing presence of young families and children in the region.
- The **25-34** age group recorded 27% growth, **outpacing Manitoba** by 7%.
- The **35-44** age group saw slow annual growth until 2018, but has since **accelerated** significantly. This group recorded **second-highest growth**, increasing 33.2% in the last decade.
- The **45-54** age group is **shrinking provincially** (-3%), whereas **SH-SS saw a 4% increase** a shift from a period of no growth observed between 2013-2023.
- The 55-64 age group grew at a much higher rate in SH-SS (+20%) than in Manitoba (+8%).



### **Population Projections**

In The Year 2034:

- Southern Health-Santé Sud is projected to grow steadily, with different demographic scenarios influencing the rate of change
- Under the **medium-growth scenario** (MMM), the population is expected to reach **277,566 by 2034**, an increase of 19%.
- The senior population (65-79) is projected to grow significantly (30.7%), with the 80+ age group increasing to 13,806 in 2034 (+75.6%)
- The working-age population (18-64) is projected to remain the largest age group, reaching 159,128 (+18.5%) in 10 years.


